- Excellent interpersonal skills to communicate with membership (including our players and coaches) and key stake holders is a prerequisite
- The ability to develop and expand Girls' Hockey at the grassroots level in the NYC Tri-State area
- The ability to develop a coaching staff and ladder commensurate with top rated programs

Responsibilities:

- Direct and control the day-to-day operations of the Girls Hockey Program;
 - Recruit, train, develop and supervise coaches
 - Organize and conduct try-outs
 - Schedule practices and games
 - Attend practices, games and tournaments
 - Organize and run a development program for girls 10 years old and younger
- Work with the Board of Directors, Director of Hockey Operations and Boys Directors to develop sponsorships and special events
 - Arrange and conduct hockey clinics, power skating clinics, pre-tryout clinics, tournaments and other special programs
 - Market and promote the Colonials Hockey Program
- Coordinate, identify and develop relationships with women's college ice hockey programs
- Acquire full knowledge of and abiding by, all applicable rules and regulations of USA Hockey, Mid-Atlantic Women's Hockey Association (MAWHA) and other applicable leagues.
 - Attending Mid-Atlantic Women's Hockey Association meetings and other meetings of leagues in which the Hockey Program participates;

The New Jersey Colonials is the largest club organization in the Atlantic District with over 650 boys and girls enrolled in our program. The organization is a charitable, 501(c) organization which is celebrating its 50th anniversary in 2018.

The girls' section has current enrollment of over 250 female athletes, comprised of 14 team ranging from 8U Developmental to 19U.
