



Grand Valley State University's Women's Club Hockey program is seeking qualified candidates for the Head Coaching position at the ACHA Division I level, to start the 2018-2019 season. This position is part-time with a stipend of \$7,500. Transportation and lodging for away events provided by the team. Funding for the hire of an assistant coach is also available.

About GVSU D1 Women's Hockey:

The GVSU D1 Women's Ice Hockey program prides itself in a tradition of excellence with 6 national tournament appearances since the team was formed in 2007. The team won the CCWHA playoffs in 2016 and finished as runner-up at nationals the same year.

The Head Coach is responsible for organizing and planning all practices as well as managing personnel and mentoring the student athletes. Coaches are expected to travel to all home and away competitions. The Head Coach will be working closely with the team executive board and Campus Recreation personnel. Duties for the position throughout the year, included, but are not limited to, recruiting, ACHA related business, and communication with our e-board members about scheduling and planning. The hockey season currently runs from the end of August to the beginning of March.

Job Responsibilities:

- Plan, develop, and attend weekly practices and minimal preseason activities
- Schedule all home and away games
- Work with other coaches to create an effective game plan and discipline code
- Interviewing and hiring assistants will be at your own discretion
- Have open lines of communication with the ACHA, members of the team and Campus Recreation administration

Job Qualifications:

Required

- Previous high level coaching experience
- Strong management and communication skills
- Valid driver's license and ability to complete and pass a background check
- A current American Red Cross First Aid/CPR/AED certification, or the ability to obtain one before the season begins

Preferred

- Has a USA Hockey Level 4 coaching certification or can acquire one before the start of the season
- Strong ties to the local hockey community
- Ability to recruit athletes to GVSU
