Job Description for Player Development Coach / Mentor, TPH-Detroit

- Represent Total Package Hockey in a manner befitting its reputation.
- Provide mentorship and take an active role in the hockey, athletic, academic and personal development of all players.

- Maintain an active role in recruiting quality players to the Center of Excellence. This includes but is not limited to:
 - Attending area tournaments, showcases and weekday games.
 - Evaluate player performance.
 - Communicate with coaches, team managers and advisers regarding potential CoE attendees.
 - Communicate with prospective CoE students and families.
 - Utilize TPH's Pipedrive recruiting software and comply with all directives.
- Serve as an on-ice instructor for all on-ice training sessions for the Center of Excellence and summer 8 Week Progression Program. Take the lead in providing instruction in the overall skill areas of *skating*, *shooting* and *stick skills* and support in other on-ice areas as needed. Additional responsibilities related to this include collaborating with all members of the staff on daily planning, collecting footage of on-ice training sessions, as well as providing locker room monitoring when necessary.
- Serve as an on-ice instructor for Fall Team Training programs. Responsibilities include building and executing a practice plan that is consistent with TPH's on-ice player development plan.
- Serve as an on-ice instructor for additional TPH programs, such as:
 - Contracted player development agreements with local youth hockey associations. Responsibilities include building and executing an on-ice plan and collaborating with additional staff members when necessary.
