The goalie coach will have the opportunity to coach goalies at practices, clinics, camps, and at private and semi-private lessons.

This position requires time management skills as candidate will divide their time between AM lessons afternoon and evening practices as well as periodic camps and clinics. The coach will also work at several area rinks, including our own.

Compensation for the duties and responsibilities include, but are not limited to, the following:

Player skills lessons:

- Private Lessons (1 player) \$25.00 per lesson
- Semi-Private (2 players) \$25.00 per lesson
- Group Lesson (3 or more) \$40.00 per lesson

Note that in a sample 5 month period, 66 player lessons were done for \$8,810.00 compensation at these rates

Clinics is 40% of revenue after ice costs (\$250 per hour) and shooters (\$10-\$15 per hour per shooter)

Camps \$500 per week plus 5% commission of paid registration fee per player after 12 registered players

Spring and Summer Hat Trick Hockey Program (Controlled Scrimmages) \$25 per hour

Tryouts for Reston Hockey Club: \$35 per on-ice session, usually an hour and 20 minutes (these are twice per year in Spring/March and Summer/June)

Adult 3-on-3 League: 10% of profit. Must have minimum of 20 teams registered and paid (140 players)

Adult Learn To Play: 10% of profit. Must have minimum of 30 players registered and paid.

Rink Management and administrative work \$15 per hour. These duties include, but are not limited to Zamboni driving, ice edging, ice rink maintenance, front desk and events coverage to fill out 40 hours per week.

Given the player lessons and the work at the facility, we estimate that you can earn over \$3,500 per month, which is over \$40,000 per year in addition to income from camps, clinics, and tryouts and any other new stream of revenue that you make take the initiative to create.

Benefits

One week (40 hours) paid vacation in year 1. Vacation time available for use after 6-month of employment.
Two weeks (80 hours) paid vacation in year 2+.
