Purpose of Position: Help start and grow our Women's Hockey Program at Maryville University assisting in all aspects of coaching and recruiting

General Summary:

This fall, Maryville University will start competing in its second season in the American Collegiate Hockey Association (ACHA). In just one year, the program has expanded to two teams, an ACHA Men's D1 and ACHA Men's D2 team. Next season (20-21) will be the first season of our Women's ACHA team. The program is overseen by Maryville Athletics and under the tutelage of Director of Hockey Operations John Hogan. Earlier this summer, Tommy Lange was hired as our first ever Women's Head Coach. Tommy will have over a year to recruit a highly competitive team to start competing the fall of 2020. Our women's team will start competing in ACHA Women's D2 but plan to make the jump to ACHA Women's D1 as soon as possible.

Maryville Hockey is proud to call the new Maryville University Hockey Center in the Chesterfield Valley home. Locker rooms, coaches' offices, video rooms, and ice availability will only be matched by NCAA D1 programs. As the teams' success and talent grows in the coming years, the University will consider adding additional teams and moving the program into the NCAA Division I ranks.

Job Description:

Maryville Hockey Women's Graduate Assistant Coach will report on a day to day basis to the Head Women's Hockey Coach. The individual will assist with multiple administrative and coaching aspects of the program, including but not limited to; coaching and recruiting. The Graduate Assistant Coach is primarily responsible for assisting with program needs as assigned by the Head Coach including:
