



Goalie Coach Job Responsibilities

1. **Development of Goalies:**

- Run shooting/skill development drills for (Goalies) pre/post practice, 3-4 times per week.
- Work shooters into drills as necessary
- Help on the ice with daily practice plans
- Analyze video of individuals goalies' game-by-game basis
- Tag goalie touches share with affiliate
- Work on skill drills pre/post practice that simulate game situations
- Psychological and personal meetings with individual goalies (with and without Tad)
- Communicate w/ coaching staff with individual goalie performance rankings after each game 1-5 scale

2. **Game Video:**

- Live tag all games
- Provide clips of all goalie touches to affiliate
- Live Tag any "Coaches Clips" you feel will be important to discuss post game or the following morning
- Analyze and break down opponent's goaltending
- Aid in the preparation of a playoff goalie pre-scout
- Coordinate all video responsibilities (connections, monitors, hardware)

3. **Other Responsibilities:**

- Provide input and assist with the execution of the practice plans
- Assist with optional practices and some Pre-Game skates (Tad & Asst communicate on schedule)
- Partake in discussions pertaining to future players and team development

4. **Recruiting**

- Create NCAA, CIS, CHL recruiting spreadsheets of top 10 Goalies
- Create SPHL / Free Agent In-season Goalie List
- Build relationships with NCAA coaches

- Voice your opinion in a professional and constructive manner.
