Duties & Responsibilities:

- Game day responsibilities.
- Administrative responsibilities related to scheduling, organizing, and general office work.

- Community involvement and fundraising activities.
- Adhere to NCAA rules and regulations.

Experience and Qualifications:

- Applicants must be accepted into and matriculating in a Franklin Pierce University graduate education program.
- Bachelor's degree is required.
- Collegiate playing experience preferred.
