Wyoming Seminary College Preparatory School seeks a Head Varsity Boys Ice Hockey Coach who is responsible for providing leadership and direction to all facets of the ice hockey program in advancing the mission of Wyoming Seminary and the Athletic Department. Sem's hockey program is an associate member of the New England Preparatory School Athletic Council (NEPSAC). The team is also a member of the Midwest Prep Hockey League (MPHL), along with Lake Forest Academy, Gilmour Academy, Shady Side Academy, Rice Academy, St. Francis High School, and five Canadian programs.

Specific areas of responsibility include, but are not limited to: sport-specific coaching, student-athlete development, program administration, and program advancement yielding agreed upon results. All activities shall be conducted within the policies and resource framework of Wyoming Seminary and the Athletic Department.

Responsibilities:

- Plans, develops, administers, and oversees the boys ice hockey program and its 20-35 student-athletes
- Provides leadership and instruction in the development of student-athletes by counseling team members in academic, citizenship, sportsmanship, and personal matters as needed
- Works with the Athletic Department on practice, training, and game schedules
- Communicates with students, parents, opponents, and administration in a timely and effective manner
- Works with the Admission Office to successfully recruit mission-appropriate applicants to join the school community
- Oversees the development and progress of each student-athlete
- Collaborates with the Athletic Department colleagues, Admission Office, Advancement Office, Communications, Upper and School faculty and staff, and the broader school community
- Sport-specific budget management, planning, and reconciliation
- Sport-specific equipment ordering, organization, management, distribution, and return
- Leads and directs the coaching staff

- Works closely with the Athletic Department and its Athletic Training Staff for the care and prevention of athletic injuries and supports the overall drug and alcohol education program for student-athletes

- Bachelor's degree or demonstrated professional competency
- A passion for athletic competition and the ability to motivate and inspire student-athletes
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills
- Commitment to building a diverse, equitable and inclusive school community
