The Equipment Manager will be responsible for:

Key Responsibilities:

Equipment Maintenance: Inspect, maintain, and repair all hockey equipment. Sharpen skates and manage skate inventory. Ensure all gear is safe, clean, and in top condition.

Inventory Management: Track and manage inventory of all team equipment. Order new equipment and supplies as needed. Maintain detailed records of equipment usage and needs.

Game and Practice Preparation: Prepare locker rooms for games and practices. Set up and break down equipment for all home and away games. Manage the transportation of equipment to away games.

Logistics and Travel: · Coordinate equipment logistics for travel, including packing and transportation. · Ensure all equipment arrives at away venues in a timely manner. · Assist with team travel arrangements as needed.

Team Support: Work closely with coaches, players, and other staff to meet equipment needs. Provide on-the-spot equipment repairs during games and practices. Assist with other team-related duties as required.
