

Immediate Opening: Maccabi USA Ice Hockey seeks an Assistant Coach for its Open Men's Ice Hockey Team

Maccabi USA's Ice Hockey program seeks an Asst. Coach to support our Open Men's Ice Hockey Team during the 2025 Maccabiah Games in Israel. The Open Men's team is composed of athletes generally aged 18 to mid/late 20s that currently or recently played college hockey. The Asst. Coach will support the Head Coach in all hockey related responsibilities for practices and games. Further, the Asst. Coach will assist in team supervision off-ice during non-hockey activities, including, but not limited to, travel, touring, educational programs, and organized events. The entire hockey program and USA delegation maintain a team of additional support staff and security to support all teams. The team will travel to Israel in late June and most of July for a training camp, a touring program, and the Maccabiah Games.

The Maccabiah Games are the second largest sporting event in the world and affectionately known as the "Jewish Olympics." The USA delegation comprises approximately 1,200+ team members while the Games will host approximately 10,000 athletes from approximately 80 countries in 40+ sports.

Qualifications:

- Must identify as Jewish.
- Must be available to travel to Israel from June 29 to July 22 or 23, 2025.
- Must have a passport valid through February 1, 2026.
- USA Passport, Green Card, or E2 Investment Visa holder preferred.
- Coaching experience at the Junior, Major Junior, and/or College level preferred.
- High level playing experience preferred.
- USA Hockey coaching certification preferred.
- Must be SafeSport certified before departure.
- Must be able to pass a background check, work with athletes under 18 years of age, lawfully permitted to travel outside the United States, and lawfully enter the State of Israel.

Note: This is a volunteer position that requires a \$3,000 program tuition for ALL coaches, staff, managers, and team physicians. The program tuition covers international airfare, lodging in a double occupancy hotel room for the duration of the program, meals, USA team apparel and coaching uniform, touring, and education programming.

Candidates will be evaluated on a rolling basis until the position is filled.
