Qualifications:

- Bachelor's degree required
- Must be admitted into a PC graduate program
- Prior experience with collegiate Hockey

Work Schedule and Conditions:

- This is a 20-hour per week position. Work hours follow normal business hours (between 8:30 –4:30, M-F) and do not include night or weekend responsibilities.
- This position is suitable for students admitted to any graduate program but may be particularly suited to students in the Higher Education, Business Analytics, MSSA or MBA programs.
- This is a 12-month (calendar year) position with a preferred start date of July 1, 2026.
- This position ends on May 16, 2027, but is renewable for a second year (or until program requirements are met, if less than 2 years) based on academic and professional performance.
- Students must be able to take 1 course in their program during Summer Session 2 to start on June 26. Otherwise the start date moves to August 26.
